# **May Ministry Highlight**



Each year, churches in the Minnesota Annual Conference take a **Love Offering** for missions in conjunction with our Annual Conference.

The theme of the 2024 Annual Conference—which will take place May 29-30—is "Jesus. Redeemer."

Our Love Offering this year will help our neighbors—in Minnesota and around the world—heal from trauma and find safety.

- Thirty percent of the Love Offering will go to a new trauma care center in Ukraine.
- Thirty percent of the Love Offering will go to immigration legal support in partnership with Volunteer Lawyer Network.
- Thirty percent of the Love Offering will go to special programming aimed at reducing trauma at Emma Norton Services' new Restoring Waters facility.
- Ten percent of the Love Offering each year goes to Volunteers in Mission scholarships, which support first-time mission trip participants.
