"Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep."


(Romans 12:15 ESV)

"This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it!" (Psalm 118:24 ESV)


"Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!" (Psalm 32:11 ESV)


A woman invited some people to dinner. At the table, she turned to her six-year-old daughter and said, "Would you like to say the blessing?"
